After a fun-filled morning at the park we take time out for lunch at Ocean Basket, Century City.



Lunch is followed by a visit to Canal Walk's Kids World, one of the coolest and fun-filled kids' clubs around Cape Town. This riveting and entertaining club is exclusive for kids ages four to twelve and provides children the hippest news, newsletters, birthday gifts, and exciting Fun Zone and craft corner in Cape Town. This venue offers a broad range of exciting activities for children, like Masks and Crowns, to keep the kids content and busy for hours on end.

## Day 3: Adventure and Fun

This morning after breakfast we set sail for an adventure on the high seas, on the Jolly Roger Pirate Boat for a live pirate show that will thrill the whole family.



After a morning on the sea, we go to another family fun-filled adventure at Cool Runnings and go downhill on a tobogganing track. Here we go hurtling down a half-pipe in a bobsled, flying through the twists and curves as we race along the 1.25 km track. It's fun, it's fast, and it's safe!

## Day 4: Animal Kingdom

After breakfast we head out to Exotic Animal World, previously Butterfly World for a full day encounter with the animals including lunch.

At Exotic Animal World they care for over 700 small animals, from fish to amphibians, from reptiles to birds and from mammals to invertebrates. A large section of the unique sanctuary is a specially designed enclosed tropical garden where we walk freely among tropical birds, lemurs and iguanas.

The enclosed garden not only gives the animals far more space to roam but allows for special 'no barriers' interaction as we watch the animals go about their day.





On top of the tropical gardens the animal world also has a walk-in aviary, complete with birds above and guinea pigs below. We also pass the reptile bay, home to the baby tortoises and beautiful boas (safely behind glass!). The aquarium doesn't just hold fish, but other exotic creatures that many will have never seen before. From there we move on to the creepy crawlly house, if you don't mind big spiders, of course. For those fonder of the cute and cuddly, just cross the river to say hello to the meerkats and the Nigerian pygmy goats not to mention a whole crowd of other residents just waiting for a visit.

## Day 5: Cape Town Iconic Sites

After breakfast we visit two of three world heritage sites found in Cape Town, Robben Island and Table Mountain.

Our first stop is Robben Island as we board the Robben Island Ferry for our voyage across the bay to the infamous maximum-security prison that once was home to various political prisoners including the late Nelson Mandela. This World Heritage Site and museum is a poignant reminder of the price paid for freedom. Our tour includes a return ferry to the island, a bus tour on the island and an integrated tour of the prison.



On our return from the island, we go up Table Mountain. The indigenous Khoisan people of the Cape named the mountain Hoerikwaggo, which means 'Mountain in the Sea'. Portuguese explorer, Antionio de Saldanha, was the first white man to hike the Mountain. He did so in 1503 and named the mountain Taboa de Cabo. This means 'Table of the Cape.' Following this, around 1652, Dutch settlers started calling it Tafelberg, which translates as Table Mountain. It is thought to be one of the oldest mountains in the world, older than the Alps, Andes, Rockies and the Himalayas.

## Day 6: What a View!

Today after breakfast we head out to The Cape of Good Hope. With numerous beaches, dozens of amazing viewpoints, a fascinating maritime history, and plenty of unique fauna and flora, it's impossible to fit everything that Cape Point has to offer in one visit. So, today we take in some of the most breathtaking ocean and mountain scenery in the world as we ride the Flying Dutchman Funicular up to the viewing point, below the old lighthouse.

For lunch we sample world-class cuisine and enjoy the most spectacular vistas over False Bay at the Two Oceans Restaurant.

After lunch we shop for curios and mementos at the three Cape Point shops.
