Closer to the ocean you will not get. Come and watch as the dolphins and whales pass by while enjoying our lay beds and drinks. Experience our candle light evenings with our fire boma out looking the ocean. Enjoy our scrumptious breakfast with a starter in our lounge or on the beach if the weather permits. Swimming in the ocean or our pool, sunbathing, fishing, drone fishing and strolling on the beach is just a few activities that you can experience at Bay Lodge. Day 1: Arrival

Today we are chauffeur driven from our homes in luxury vehicles to the airport for our flight to Mossel Bay.

In Mossel Bay we take a pits-top at Cafe Gannet for lunch.

After lunch we check in at Bay Lodge on the Beach.

Afternoon at leisure to soak in the atmosphere and to get acquainted with the facilities.

Supper at the hotel.



Day 2: Celebrate Our Heritage

Our stay in Mossel Bay begins with a visit to a place where all humans originated - Point of Human Origins. The Point of Human Origins Experience full day tour with Dr. Peter Nilssen is rare opportunity to visit a famous Middle Stone Age archaeological site in the company of the archaeologist who initially identified the archaeological potential in 1997, and who introduced the sites to scientific research that began in 2000.

This full day tour includes cave visits at the Pinnacle Point Site Complex followed by a three hour coastal hike, with a picnic stop along the famous St. Blaize Trail with beautiful coastal views. The experience ends at another important stone age archaeological site cave site at the iconic Point of Mossel Bay.

Later we return to the hotel for supper.



Day 3: Adventure and Adrenalin Packed

Today we wake up to a sunrise hot air balloon experience. A flight in a hot air balloon is a different kind of experience. No other form of flying comes anywhere close to its calm, serene nature. Experience the quite stillness of the morning sunrise while soaring among birds and clouds alike. This is truly what dreams are made of.

Before the flight takes off we enjoy a hot drink and traditional South African rusks as the crew set up and inflate the hot air balloon.

On landing we enjoy a glass of sparkling wine to celebrate the end of the flight before being transported to enjoy a full breakfast.





After breakfast we go on a Zipline adventure at Mossel Bay Zipline, the longest over-the-ocean Zipline in the world at a 1 150 metres and 90 metres above sea level, travelling at an average speed of 80km per hour.

After lunch at Carola Ann's Restaurant our adventure continues with a 5km quad biking ride.



After an adventurous day we return to the hotel for supper and evening relaxation.

Day 4: Into the Wild



Today we spend time in the wild at Gondwana Game Lodge to get up-close-and-personal with Mother Nature.

We begin by exploring of Gondwana's protected and endangered species area on foot with a field guide. This 1 200 hectre land is fenced to keep the wild animals at bay. Our experience includes a drive to this exclusive area where we will encounter the majesty of Fynbos Floral Kingdom as well as endagered species such as the Cape Mountain Zebra and Botenbok. We will also catch a glimpse of Eland, Giraffe, and Sable, creating a truly immersive wildlife experience.

Lunch and afternoon relaxation at the lodge.

Later in the afternoon we embark on a captivating game drive in open-game-safari vehicle led by Gondwana's skilled field guides dedicated to providing us with an immersive experience. The field guides will not only share their knowledge and passion for the magnificent reserve but also unveil its hidden treasures, offering us unforgettable encounters with nature.




After an eventful day we return to the lodge for supper and New Year's Eve Party.


Lunch at Christina's Bistro at Van Loveren.
