Day 1: Arrival

Today we are chauffeur driven from our homes in luxury vehicles to the airport for a flight to George Airport.

Upon arrival in George we take a pit-stop at Hussar Grill for lunch.

After lunch we take a road trip to Kynsna for our stay at Pezula Nature Retreat.

Day 2: Visit to a Man-made Island

Later, during the mid-morning we head to Thesen Island, in Kynsna, for a two-hour quad biking adventure. Thesen Island consists of 19 man-made islands linked by 21 arched bridges and surrounded by 25ha of tidal waterways.



The 2-hour quad biking adventure is a unique and true forest experience. Here, we enjoy an exhilarating ride on fully guided Quad Bike tour through the forests, sweepy bends, and single tracks.

Day 3: Adrenalin and Adventure on High Octane

Today we go on a Kayak & Lilo adventure up the Storms River Gorge in the Tsitsikamma National Park. Here, we explore deeper into the the hidden world of the Storms River Gorge and experience the long, bottomless pools, deep caves, and ancient indigenous forests with nothing but the quite noises of nature.



We paddle from the Storms River harbour across the ocean and pas underneath the famous Storms River Mouth Suspension Bridge. From there we kayak up the Storms River Gorge.

At the low-water point we leave our kayaks and jump onto the lilo (a small inflatable boat designed to access the narrow parts of the gorge). The lilo allows us to just float deeper up the river gorge and we weightlessly relish in the serenity of this paradise, while feeling insignificantly small as we ogle up at sky-scraping cliffs surrounding us.



Lunch and afternoon relaxation at Kasi Corner.

Later we return to the hotel for relaxation and supper.

Day 4: In Touch With Nature

Today enjoy the stunning Featherbed Nature Reserve, as we take a the ferry ride across the Kynsna Lagoon to the Western Head. From here we are taken up a beautiful 4x4 trail into the Reserve, stopping occasionally to allow us to take in the scenery and for our guide to give us all the information on various fauna and flora found in the area. We also take a 2km guided walking trail through the coastal forest int the nearby sea caves. Then later, we enjoy a delectable buffet lunch at the Reserve's outdoor restaurant.





Upon return from Featherbed Nature Reserve, we spend the afternoon at leisure at The Waterfront Knysna Quays. This is one of Kynsna's most popular leisure and shopping destinations. Here, there is a perfect mix of leisure, shopping, dining, and waterfront activities. The Waterfront is a shopper's paradise with the perfect gift for everyone. There are also various restaurants that cater to every taste.

Later in the afternoon we take a sunset cruise with dinner and full premium bar on a private yacht.



Day 5: Me-Time
