# 8 Days of Absence from Civilization



Nibbana Farm is a working farm situated in the Witzenberg Valley, surrounded by a backdrop of majestic mountains. This beautiful rural area in the heart of the Winelands of the Western Cape, not far from the historic town of Tulbagh, is the perfect place for a getaway. The garden surrounding the Manor house is decorated with beautiful flowers, shrubs and trees. It offers spacious lounge areas where you can relax, read a book, have a swim and just enjoy the sense of being. The abundant nature around Nibbana farm offers many chances for fantastic hikes around the 190-hectare farm, whether you want to stay out for a whole day or just a few hours. Strenuous rock climbs, a visit to the stunning waterfall, easy strolls through the fynbos vegetation or just you meander around the garden to discover the collection of contemporary art. It's your choice! Nibbana Farm is fortunate and

unique with its abundance of cold mountain water. This is a rare treat in Africa and we propose you indulge in it while you can. Hike up to the waterfall. If you dare take a dip in the ice-cold crystal-clear water. Enjoy the many rock pools in the magnificent Secret Garden. Nothing is more perfect than a swim in one of the large farm dams after hiking the mountainous terrain.

## Day 1: Arrival

Today we are chauffeur driven from our homes in luxury vehicles to the airport for a flight to Cape Town International Airport.

Upon arrival in Cape Town International Airport, we are transported in luxury vehicles to Nibbana Farm in the Witzenberg Valley near the historic town of Tulbagh.

After lunch at Readers Restaurant, we check in at Nibbana Farm.

We then spend the afternoon at leisure at the lodge to soak in the atmosphere.

## Day 2: Tulbagh History

After breakfast at Koe en Deeg we head over to the town of Tulbagh, the fourth oldest town in South Africa, after Cape Town, Stellenbosch and Swellendam, to learn more about the history of this town.

Our history lesson starts at Church Street which has more Cape Dutch, Edwardian and Victorian provincial heritage sites than any other street in the country.





We take a long, slow walk along Church Street to look at beautiful buildings that were restored after a massive earthquake in 1969 that measured 6.3 on the Richter scale and killed 12 people, most of the children.

Each building has a plaque in front telling us what it used to be, how badly it was damaged and how it was restored.

Along Church Street there is also Earthquake Museum which documents the events of 1969 and paints a picture of the restoration of Church Street.

There are three other museums worth visiting along Church Street: Oude Kerk, one of the last surviving cruciform Churches in South Africa and was built in 1803 as a postmaster's house.

After the informative and interesting history lesson lunch is served at Padagang Restaurant.

After lunch we return to the farm for afternoon relaxation.

Later we head out to Harvest Table Bistro for supper.

### **Day 3: New Year's Eve Celebration**

Breakfast at Kloofzicht Farm Deli & Foolish Things.

This morning we take 1,5 hour scenic horse trail ride. Our route meanders through the forests and fynbos into the foothills of the Witzenberg Mountains with panoramic views of the valley and majestic backdrop of the mountains. This is a private trail which is comfortable for even beginners as we ride at our own pace.

We end off the ride with a picnic lunch at a secluded picnic area.

We return to the farm for afternoon relaxation.

Today being New Year's Eve Day, why not celebrate it in style with an All-Jeans New Year's Eve Party. The party includes spit braai supper, tapas and snacks and a fully stocked bar.

Mo and Phindi, former hosts of The Family from Kaya FM, are the hosts of the party.



### **Day 4: Saturday on the Farm**

Breakfast at Kole en Deeg.

Every Saturday from 10:00 – 16:00 Oude Kloof Wine Estate hosts "Saturday on the Farm" where we go and hang out and spend the day on the farm, listen to live music, purchase fresh farm foods, enjoy some pizza or even indulge in Grandma's traditional Sunday lunch.

Later we return to the farm for afternoon relaxation before supper at Daphne's Restaurant.



## Day 5: All White Party

Today, after breakfast at Chef and Co we spend the morning at leisure at the farm.



In the afternoon it is time to put on the swimming costume and shorts and get ready for the Pool Party with full catering (lunch and supper) and beverages.

## Day 6: After the Fact

Breakfast at Obiqua Cafe at Duikersdrift.

Today we spend our time at leisure on the farm to recover from the effects of yesterday's celebrations. The farm garden is decorated with beautiful flowers, shrubs and trees and offers spacious lounge area where you can relax, read a book, have a swim and just enjoy a sense of being there.

There is also an amazing Secret Garden which is enclosed by a stone wall. This secluded oasis is simply an amazing place to linger in. Enjoy a nap in one of the hammocks, go for a swim in one of the natural crystal clear pools or in the nearby dam.

Lunch and supper with a fully stocked bar.

## Day 6: Fun in the Sun

After breakfast at Rijk's Restaurant we go on a scenic tractor ride up the historic Oudekloof Pass to enjoy the mountains and the views out over Tulbagh. This trip at Oudekloof Wine Estate takes about two hours and includes a picnic at the top. Here we learn a bit about the history of the area.





After the tractor ride with a picnic lunch, we visit the Ceres Zip Slide Adventures for some zipline adrenaline rush on eight slides from 100 to 290m long among the rock formations of the Schurweberg.
