Today, after breakfast we spend the morning at The Woods Paintball Range on a desolate plot north of Fourways Shopping Mall. Just the setting alone is good enough to bring the G.I. Joe in you. Here we get all the gear needed to get on the range for 3 hours. The Woods Paintball Range is located inside a beautiful forest. The realistic setting allows us to feel the rush of adrenaline as we dash through the forest. This is an opportunity for everyone (men and women) to run wild on the range.

After lunch at Wandie's Place in Soweto we continue with the adventure and adrenaline rush at Soweto Towers. Recently extended to 100m, the outdoor climbing wall at Soweto Towers is the perfect place to challenge your abilities from different angles. The setting is what makes it so great – the Soweto Towers are one of the most distinctive landmarks in Soweto. They are a site of the world's first bungee jumps between two cooling towers.

Today we head to Xtreme Indoor Karting for some fun and exhilaration. 
And then... we return to @Sandton Hotel for lunch, supper and relaxation. There are several facilities for relaxation depending on one's preferences:





Day 6: Out and About

Today after breakfast we head over to Plett Game Reserve where we experience the magic of the African bush with a two-hour game drive on the 2,200-hectare reserve at the foothills of the Tsitsikamma Mountains. The knowledgeable game rangers will enthrall us with interesting facts about the wildlife on our safari. Plett Game Reserve is home to three of Africa's famous Big 5, with the arrival of elephants to complement the rhinos and leopards. We also encounter many species of antelope, giraffe, zebra, hippo and crocodiles.

Birdlife at the game reserve is also abundant, as are the smaller buck and other wild animals that inhabit this protected area of the Garden Route.



After a morning with the animals we head over to Wild X Adventures where we go on a guided 7km quad biking adventure. This is a whole lot of fun in the forest and the bush, twisting through trees and around bends. Quad bike rides are suitable for first time riders because they ride automatic.

Day 7: Life's a Beach

Beach walking in the Garden Route includes some of the most breath-taking Blue Flag beaches in the world. Plettenberg Bay specifically has some of the most beautiful beaches in South Africa. The town's 20 kilometres of picturesque Indian Ocean coastline features pristine, unspoilt sandy beaches. Today after breakfast we head out to Robberg 5 Beach. Robberg 5 Beach is one of Plettenberg Bay's finest beaches, stretching for kilometres from central Plettenberg Bay towards the Robberg Peninsula. Due to its pristine conditions and excellent facilities, Robberg has been given prestigious Blue Flag status. The warm, calm waters are ideal for swimming, while the long sandy beaches are great for romantic strolls. The beach is known for shore-based dolphin, seal, and whale watching, particularly during the winter months. Lifeguards are on duty throughout the season. Other features include umbrella and chair rentals, upgraded wheelchair friendly facilities, and parking spots. Interpretive signage provides interesting information about the fauna and flora of the area.

After lunch we indulge our 007 fantasy and whiz around in the waves on a Jet Ski to the envy of all on the beach. They're super-fast and super-fun. We get kitted out with a wetsuit and life jacket, then we either "piggy-back" with a qualified skipper or take the controls ourselves. A temporary skipper license is issued on the day.

Day 8: Oudtshoorn Exploration

This morning, we wake up to a 2,5hour trip to Oudtshoorn, located in the Klein Karoo, and renowned as the "ostrich capital of the world". Situated between Swartberg and Outeniqua Mountain ranges, it's known for its fertile valley, diverse natural landscapes, and ostrich farming.

Our first stop is the Meerkat Adventure for a sunrise meerkat experience, weather dependent, as the meerkats only venture outside their burrows at sunrise and not on rainy days. Meerkats are part of the so-called Shy 5, which includes the bat-eared fox, the aardvark, porcupine, and aardwolf. On arrival we are treated to a hot cup of coffee, and then we are issued with lightweight aluminium chairs to sit while observing the meerkats as they come out of their burrows into the sunshine and then go about their daily routine of foraging and frolicking. This is a fantastic experience and a unique privilege to get this close to these little creatures in their natural habitat.



After breakfast at Nostalgie Restaurant we visit the Cango Caves. Known for being one of the largest show cave systems in Africa, Cango Caves are situated in a limestone ridge near the Swartberg Mountains, and characterised by vast halls, intricate drip stone formations (stalactites and stalagmites) and a network of tunnels. The caves are not just a natural wonder, but also a place of historical and cultural significance.

The caves offer Heritage Tours with easier walking paths and Adventure Tours, which are more challenging and involve crawling, sliding on belly or back, and climbing to understand what spelunking is. Each person will choose which tour they would like to do - Heritage or Adventure.



In the afternoon our Oudtshoorn exploration continues at Highgate Ostrich Farm for an up-close-and-personal encounter with the ostrich. Highgate Ostrich Farm offers ostrich tour which are not only enlightening but also fun. Apart from the breathtaking views of the Klein Karoo Valley and Swartberg Mountains we learn about ostrich incubators, feed the ostrich by hand, visit a breeding camp as well as enjoy a three-course meal of ostrich egg and meat.



Afternoon relaxation at Route 62 Bar & Grill.

Later in the afternoon we take a road trip back to Plettenberg Bay for supper at the hotel.

Day 8: Home Sweet Home

Today after breakfast we say goodbye to Tsala Treehouse as we are chauffeured to Plettenberg Bay Airport for our flight to OR Tambo International Airport.

At OR Tambo International Airport we are chauffeur driven to our respective homes.
