Today you and your better half are chauffeur driven from home in luxury vehicles to the to Rustenburg.

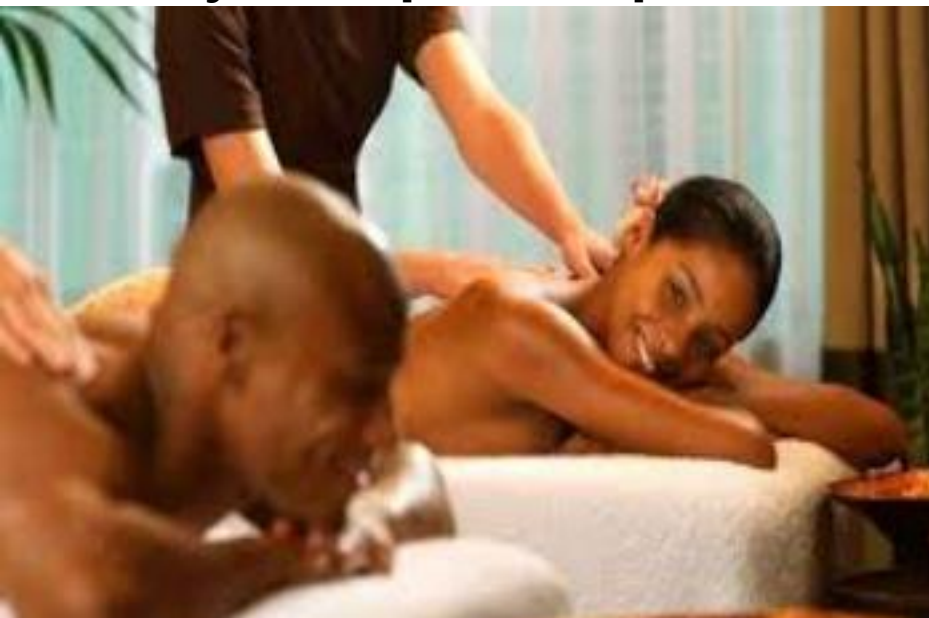
After lunch at Legends Restaurant at Soho Hotel, Sun City, you check in at Palace of the Lost City.

At sunrise you set off to Pilansberg National Park for an unforgettable safari experience starting with a hot air balloon ride over the Pilansberg National Park to get a bird's eye view of the inhabitants of the park. The hot air balloon flight lasts for about an hour. On landing you are served sparkling wine and orange juice to celebrate the flight before being transported to a private lodge within the park where a full English breakfast is served.



After breakfast you go into the bush on open safari vehicle in search of the Big 5. Pilansberg National Park is the fourth largest game park in South Africa and is located where a volcano crater erupted 1300 million years ago. The park boasts over 7000 animals, 360 bird species and more than 200km of road. Some of the most beautiful scenery within the park can be seen in the Mankwe Dam region. The dam is the largest body of water in the game reserve, making it the perfect place to spot a wide variety of animals that make a stopover on the grassland bordering the dam.

Return to the Palace for lunch at the Grill Restaurant.

Spend the rest of the afternoon relaxing at the Palace Pool Deck for a refreshing African inspired cocktail while you soak up in the sun or Task Bar Lounge or relax with an afternoon High Tea and enjoy a variety of teas while tucking into a delicious selection of pastries, cakes, savoury nibbles in a palatial African setting.
