After lunch we visit Epic Karting Midlands for some adrenaline-charged experience as we race against each other with accurate lap times to ensure bragging rights for winning each event.

We return to the hotel to get ourselves ready for New Year's Eve Party.

After supper at Skye Bistro at the hotel it's time for the New Year's Eve Party with fully stocked bar, hosted by Paul Mtirara of The Chill Factor on Metro FM.



Day 5: Pampering and Relaxation



Today we unwind, relax and be pampered with a full day spa treatment at Fordoun Spa. Spa treatments include full body massages, facials, hand and feet treatments including manicures and pedicures.

Day 6: Easy Like Sunday Morning



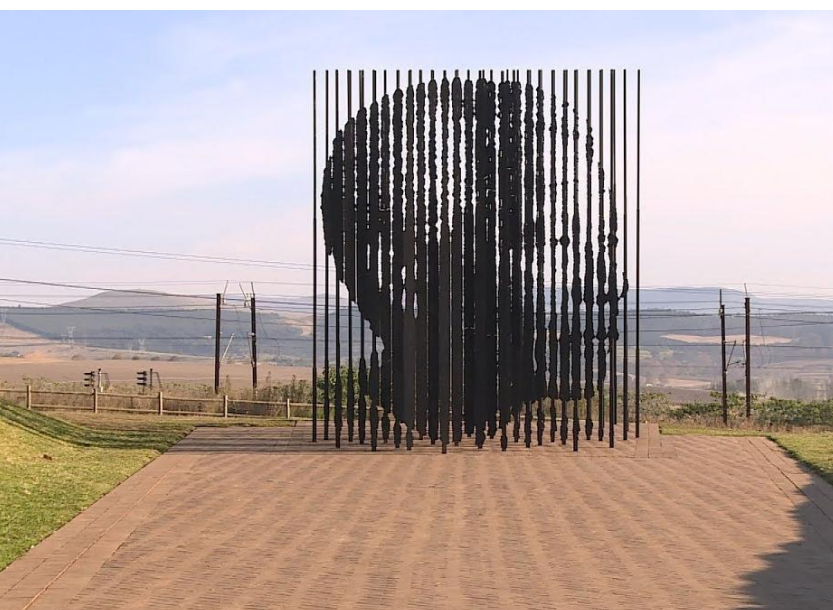
Today is Sunday and we spend the morning at leisure at the hotel.

In the afternoon we head out to Brahman Hills. Our afternoon at Brahman Hills includes a la carte lunch, afternoon high tea with sweet and savoury treats along with coffee, tea and juice.

Later in the evening we enjoy a private three course supper with wine pairing.

Day 7: Long Walk to Freedom

Today we wake up to a sunrise hot air balloon experience. Our hot air balloon experience starts with a hot cup of tea/coffee and biscuits as the crew prepare the balloon. We then go up in the air on a one-hour flight and see the world from the perspective of the birds. This is an experience to remember. After landing we are treated to a sparkling wine and full Continental breakfast.



Later, after breakfast we follow the route that Nelson Mandela used leading to his arrest in the Howick area and his imprisonment for 27 years in Robben Island. The Mandela Capture was created as a remembrance to that fateful arrest.

We then visit the Howick Falls, a waterfall which is approximately 95m in height and lies in the Umgeni River. The AmaZulu called the falls "KwaNoggaza" which means a place of the Tall One. Howick Falls are simply breathtaking and the deafening rush of the water from the viewing deck is incredibly relaxing and mystifying at the same time. Several arts and craft stalls are found on the viewing platform with a small coffee shop along the way.

Lunch at Village at Yard 41.

We return to the hotel for afternoon relaxation and supper.



Day 8: Bucket List Experience

Today we experience one of the world's most extreme mountain passes. This one is not for the faint-hearted as we take a precariously spectacular, scenic, and winding, bending turns on a 4x4 Sani Pass experience. We travel through this World Heritage Site to an altitude of 2 876m above sea level to reach the Eastern Highlands of Lesotho via the Drakensberg mountain range. We stop in Lesotho at a local village followed by a relaxed lunch and drinks at the Highest Pub in Africa.

Later in the evening we return to the hotel for supper.



Day 9: Home Sweet Home

Today after breakfast we say goodbye to the Fordoun and are chauffeur driven to King Shaka International Airport for our flight back home.

At OR Tambo International Airport we are chauffeur driven to our respective homes.
