The Oyster Box is one of South Africa's most celebrated hotels, as famous for its remarkable coastal views as the understated luxury and gracious hospitality that have become the hallmarks of this cherished seaside destination. The hotel offers an array of individually decorated rooms and suites, an award-winning spa set amid tropical gardens, and a mouth-watering menu of restaurants and bars. Seafood is a signature, and the Curry Buffet at the Ocean Terrace is legendary, while the spectacular breakfast guarantees an inspiring start to your day.

Day 1: Arrival

Today we are chauffeur driven from our homes in luxury vehicles to the airport for a flight to Cape Town International Airport.

Upon arrival in Cape Town International Airport we are chauffeured to V&A Waterfront for lunch at Siba The Restaurant.

After lunch we check in at Cape Grace Hotel.

We then spend the afternoon at leisure at the hotel to soak in the atmosphere and to get acquainted with the hotel's facilities.

Day 2: Wine and Gin Extravaganza

South Africa is renowned for both her beer and wine, and Cape Town has some of the best wine farms and craft breweries. Today, after breakfast, we go on a tour of Stellenbosch for some wine and gin tasting with biltong and an afternoon braai thrown in for good measure! This uniquely Capetonian tour takes us to some of the best spots along the famous Stellenbosch wine route.

Our first stop is something we only find in South Africa: a wine and biltong pairing. Yep, that's wine and biltong – paired for our enjoyment while we drink in the spectacular views. This is an unforgettable experience including panoramic views, carefully chosen local biltong and remarkable

wines. This farm is also famous for serving wine at Nelson Mandela's 90th birthday celebration, some of which we can sample.



Lunch could not get any more authentic than a South African braai. We pull into a gorgeous Cape Dutch architecture styled building to find a microbrewery where we have our braai lunch. The beers on offer here are brewed in accordance with the strict German Reinheitsgebot brewing law, so you know they're good. Here we enjoy the best traditional South African braai lunch.



Our next stop boasts award winning wine paired with some of the best views in the winelands. We'll get to taste some top-drawer wines here, and you'll definitely want to pick up a few bottles when you see the great price tags.

Our last stop takes us to the home of the World's Best Craft Lager of 2014. At this microbrewery we are treated to an in-depth tour of the facilities, taste four beers (including a uniquely local Rooibos infused lager) and indulge in a draught beer of your choice.

After an eventful day we return to the hotel for supper.

Day 3: Merry Christmas

Today after breakfast, we celebrate Christmas Day in style, first by attending a Christmas Church Service at Sea Point Methodist Church. Then in the afternoon we attend a Christmas Black-Tie Luncheon at Cape Grace. The Black-Tie luncheon includes a five-course gourmet meal, paired with relevant wines.



After the gala lunch it's time for the All-Jeans Christmas Party hosted by Sentle Lehoko of The Romantic Repertoire from Metro FM with a fully stocked bar and supper.

Day 4: After the Fact

Today after breakfast we spend the morning at leisure at the hotel to recuperate from the effects of yesterday's festivities.

Lunch and afternoon relaxation at Grand Africa Café & Beach at V&A Waterfront.

Supper at Signal Restaurant at Cape Grace.

Evening entertainment and relaxation at Bascule Bar at Cape Grace. By day, Bascule is a vibrant destination from where to enjoy a cappuccino or light lunch. By night, the space is transformed into a lively bar, where connoisseurs and social butterflies gather to enjoy sundowners and lively music, savouring speciality drinks and tasty dishes as the sun dips beneath the waters' horizon.

Day 7: Sani Pass Adventure


