Day 1: Arrival

Today we take a four and half hour road trip in luxury vehicles and travel eastwards to eSwatini.

After crossing the Oshoek border post we continue our journey to Mbabane.

In Mbabane we take a pit-stop for lunch at Ramblas Restaurant.

After lunch we check in at Summerfields Botanical Gardens and Exclusive Resort.

Afternoon at leisure to soak in the atmosphere and to get acquainted with the hotel's facilities.

Supper at Grand Pavilion at the hotel.



Day 2: eSwatini Exploration

Today, we go on a full day eSwatini exploration and covers both the Northern and the Southern part places of interest in eSwatini. Our day starts with the northern highlight tour with a visit to the following places of interest:

- ❖ Here you will see the King Sobhuza 11 Memorial Parliament buildings, Somhlolo National Stadium and the Ludzidzini Royal Residence (Queen Mother's residence).

- ❖ The tour continues further to Malkerns where the next stop will be House on Fire and Gone Rural for arts and crafts.
- ❖ From then we continue Swazi Candles where you will be watching the local craftsmen doing what they best when they will be moulding all sorts of sculptures from animals. You will be given a chance to learn how to do it.
- ❖ Then last section will be the visit to the Mantenga Cultural Village where you will be taken on a 30 min tour of the traditional village where you will be familiarised with the way the ancient Swazi used to live in the past.
- ❖ This will be followed by the traditional dance.

After lunch we proceed to the southern side of eSwatini with visit to the following places of interest:

- ❖ Our tour starts with the capital city
- ❖ Visit to the Sibebe Rock.
- ❖ Ngwenya glass factory for art and craft.
- ❖ Tour will proceed to the old iron ore mine
- ❖ Next stop Maguga dam and the bushmen paintings.
- ❖ After this clients would have time for lunch (not included), after which the tour continues to the southern section
- ❖ Visit the Houses of Parliament
- ❖ Ludzidzini Royal Residence (both these places are only viewable from outside since they are not open for tourists).
- ❖ Museum
- ❖ Swazi Candle Factory.
- ❖ Mantenga Nature Reserve; in a scenic valley framed by the imposing rock of execution. Inside Mantenga Nature Reserve there is a lively swazi cultural village where you can watch a 45 minute traditional dance.



Day 3: Day at Leisure

Today we spend the day at leisure at the hotel, with mid-morning High Tea at The Summer Terrace, relaxation at the Red Feather Pool Bar, lunch at the Palm Cascade Restaurant, supper at the Grand Pavillion and post dinner drinks.

Day 4: Mpumalanga Beckons



After breakfast we take a road trip in luxury vehicles and journey to Hazeyview in Mpumalanga where we will stay at Summerfields Rose Retreat & Spa for next four days.

On arrival in Hazeyview we take a pit-stop at Pioneer's Grill.

After lunch we check-in at Summerfield Rose Retreat & Spa.

Afternoon at leisure to soak in the atmosphere and to get acquainted with the hotel's facilities.

Supper at the hotel.

Day 5: New Year's Eve

Day 7: Panorama Route

This morning after breakfast we hit the road and go to the Blyde River Canyon, the world's famous for its natural beauty, breathtaking viewpoints and magnificent waterfalls.

During this tour we visit spectacular attractions along the way including the Lisbon Falls just outside the tourist town of Graskop. From there we catch the first glimpse of the 2km Blyde River Canyon as we travel alongside it to the Three Rondavels which provides breathtaking panoramic views of the Canyon and the Lowveld from a high vantage point.

We then make our way back along the Canyon to Bourke's Luck Potholes where the Canyon starts at the confluence of the Treur and Blyde Rivers.



We take a pit stop for lunch at Blue Mountain Retreat.

From there we head off to the legendary God's Window. Just one look down and one understands why it's called God's Window. With magnificent views canyons, rock formations, waterfalls, God's Window is truly an area of breathtaking scenic splendour.

After lunch we continue our Blyde River Canyon experience, this time from the river, by taking a scenic boat ride, and see the canyon from the angle it's supposed to be seen, at the base of towering mountains that form the breathtaking views.

Later we return to the hotel for supper.



Day 8: Blue Train Experience

Today we bid farewell to Angels View and head out to Hoedspruit train station to board the Blue Train for our journey back home, Bosman Station in Pretoria.



Later a five-course gourmet lunch is served in the Blue Train.

In the late afternoon we are transferred to Numbi Gate for a sunset game drive. The sunset game drive takes place on the Nkambeni concession.

The Nkambeni concession represents an area of approximately 11 400 hectares and lies between the main entrance gates of Numbi and Phabeni and stretches past Shabeni Koppe near Pretoriuskop camp.

After the sunset game drive, we enjoy a spectacular boma dinner at Nkambeni Safari Camp before we are transferred back to The Blue Train where we enjoy post-dinner drinks, cognacs, and Cuban cigars in the before retiring to bed.

Day 9: Off-the-train Excursion

We disembark and are transferred through Numbi Gate in open safari vehicles to sunrise game drive conducted by professional tour guides.

After the sunrise game drive, we enjoy a bush Kruger National Park.

After breakfast, we return to the Blue Train for Five course lunch and supper.



Day 10: Blue Train Arrives in Pretoria

This morning we enjoy breakfast on the Blue Train.

Blue Train arrives in Pretoria.

We disembark the Blue Train and are chauffeur driven to our respective homes.
