We stare at the flames and listen to the day fading away and when we look up in wonder, we will be amazed at the ambush laid by the Milky Way.

Our Karoo Veld Soire takes place on a private Farm, conveniently located close to Graff-Reinet But still far enough to afford us the feeling of space and time that one only gets in the Karoo. The soiree is preceded by a Tequila Masterclass and dinner is prepared on the fire while we relax Next to the river.



Day 3: Nieu-Bethesda and Valley of Desolation



This morning, after breakfast, we visit the quaint hamlet of Nieu-Bethesda in the fold of the Sneeu Berg Mountains, guarded over by the imposing Compassberg, for some relaxation in the Karoo. Nieu-Bethesda does not have the usual amenities that are associated with a town but has more horses and dogs wondering around than people (although it does have its fair share of interesting characters). The village is a scenic drive from Graff-Reinet and the visit includes the Owl Museum, which is the most popular

attraction in Nieu-Bethesda, Bushman Heritage Centre, Kitching Fossil Centre, Dustcovers Bookstore, by far the best bookshop in the entire Karoo, Two Goats Deli and Brewery, for some cheese platter and beer tasting.

Lunch at Die Waenhuis Restaurant.

We return to the hotel for afternoon relaxation and to freshen for our next adventure.

In the evening we venture out to the Valley of Desolation, undoubtedly the shining diamond of attractions in and around the Gem of the Karoo. Set in a stark and beautiful 19 000-hectres Camdeboo National Park, which conserves the important Great Karoo mountain landscape around Graff-Reinet. The Valley of Desolation or Cathedral of the Mountains as it is also known, offers amazing sight to the processes of the past that formed this ancient landscape. The views out across the Plains of the Camdeboo, the enigmatic Spandau Kop, as well as over the town and its surrounding Sneeuberg peaks, is in itself a site to behold. Combine this with sundowner drinks and light snacks and we have a winning recipe.



Our Valley of Desolation Sunset tour will include a 300 metre trail walk to enjoy the best views on offer, craft rum tasting at the Afrikanis Rum Room inside Hello Restaurant and dinner at Hello You Restaurant.

Day 4 - 7: Sibuya Tented Camps Experience
