Day 1: Arrival

Today we take a two and half hour road trip to Dullstroom in Mpumalanga in luxury vehicles.

In Dullstroom we take a pit-stop at Mrs Simpsons Restaurant for lunch.

After lunch we check in at Walkersons Hotel & Spa

Supper at Flying Scotsman at the hotel.



Day 2: Dullsrooom Experience

Today, after breakfast we hit the streets of Dullstroom, also known as Emnochweni to experience this charming, small town which lies 35 kilometres north of Belfast, some 53 kilometres south-west of Lydenburg, and about 263 kilometres from Johannesburg. This town is one of South Africa's premier flyfishing destinations. It also features the highest railway station in South Africa at 2 077 metres above sea-level. Dullstroom location on the Highveld plateau is the reason that its climate is so different from the surrounding areas.




Our Dullstroom experience begins with a visit to The Clock Shop. The Clock Shop started from an idea when The Sunday Times newspaper ran a treasure hunt competition in 1989 called "Finders Keepers" by hiding R1 million prize money behind a clock in a Dullstroom pub. From there a seed was planted and The Clock Shop grew into what is now the biggest in the Southern Hemisphere. Here, they manufacture and import their own range of clocks from grandfather, wall, mantle and cuckoo clocks.

Then we take a quick stop at Dullstroom Coffe Roastery for some mid-morning snack.

Our Dullstromm experience continues at Wild About Whisky. Here, they offer tutored tastings in whiskies and all other premium spirits, and have assembled 45 cleverly arranged tasting themes to guide us through the wealth of whisky. The bar has over 1200 whiskies on offer from 20 countries. It also includes a large variety of gins, rums, brandies, cognacs, wine, beer and coffee.



After this whisky tasting experience we must have worked out our appetites. For lunch head out to Royal Coachman Restaurant



We then spend the rest of the afternoon at Walkersons Hotel with some spa treatment which includes full body massages, facial care and manicures and pedicures.

Supper at the hotel.

Day 3: Criss-crossing Continues

This morning, after breakfast we say goodbye to Walkersons Hotel.

We take a two and half hours road trip to Graskop for our stay at Angels View Hotel.

In Graskop we take a pit-stop at Garden Shed Restaurant.

After lunch we check in at Angels View Hotel.

Afternoon relaxation at the hotel to soak in the atmosphere and get acquainted with the hotel's facilities.

Day 4: Panorama Route

This morning after breakfast we hit the road and go to the Blyde River Canyon, the world's famous for its natural beauty, breathtaking viewpoints and magnificent waterfalls.



During this tour we visit spectacular attractions along the way including the Lisbon Falls just outside the tourist town of Graskop. From there we catch the first glimpse of the 2km Blyde River Canyon as we travel alongside it to the Three Rondavels which provides breathtaking panoramic views of the Canyon and the Lowveld from a high vantage point.

We then make our way back along the Canyon to Bourke's Luck Potholes where the Canyon starts at the confluence of the Treur and Blyde Rivers.

From there we head off to the legendary God's Window. Just one look down and one understands why it's called God's Window. With magnificent views canyons, rock formations, waterfalls, God's Window is truly an area of breathtaking scenic splendour.

We take a pit stop for lunch at Blue Mountain Retreat.

After lunch we continue our Blyde River Canyon experience, this time from the river, by taking a scenic boat ride, and see the canyon from the angle it's supposed to be seen, at the base of towering mountains that form the breathtaking views.

Later we return to the hotel for supper.

Day 5: New Year's Eve Party

Today its New Year's Eve and so we spend the day at the hotel to enjoy its facilities or do what one's heart desires.

In the evening its time for the New Year's Eve Party hosted by Wilson B. Nkosi with fully stocked bar.



Day 6: Happy New Year

Today we spend the day at leisure at the hotel with full catering including mid-morning snacks, lunch, afternoon snacks, premium bar and supper at the hotel.

Day 7: Graskop Gorge Experience



Today after breakfast we head out to Graskop Gorge Lift Company for a full day of adventure, entertainment and fun. Activities here include:

- The Lift which takes us 51m down the face of the gorge into the indigenous forest below. At the forest we enjoy a walk in the Afromontane Forest, where a trail of elevated walkways and suspension bridge await.
- The Zipline gives a bird's eye view of the gorge.
- The Big Swing is all about adrenaline rush. Freefall 70m into the forest under 3 seconds.
- The Suspension Bridge requires one to hold one's breath and venture across 52m suspension bridge, 70m above the gorge.

For lunch (own account) there is a choice of two cafés: Swing Café – a laid back chill zone that invites one to Get Delicious, Real Quick! Enjoy flame grilled chicken and more at the Lift Café which is a spacious and inviting restaurant and bar with the most spectacular views.

Later we return to the hotel for supper.

Day 8: Blue Train Experience

Today we bid farewell to Angels View and head out to Hoedspruit train station to board the Blue Train for our journey back home.

Later a five-course gourmet lunch is served in the Blue Train.

In the late afternoon we are transferred to Numbi Gate for a sunset game drive. The sunset game drive takes place on the Nkambeni concession.

The Nkambeni concession represents an area of approximately 11 400 hectares and lies between the main entrance gates of Numbi and Phabeni and stretches past Shabeni Kopje near Pretoriuskop camp.



After the sunset game drive, we enjoy a spectacular boma dinner at Nkambeni Safari Camp before we are transferred back to The Blue Train where we enjoy post-dinner drinks, cognacs, and Cuban cigars in the before retiring to bed.

Day 9: Off-the-train Excursion



We disembark and are transferred through Numbi Gate in open safari vehicles to sunrise game drive conducted by professional tour guides.

After the sunrise game drive, we enjoy a bush breakfast at an exclusive unfenced location inside the Kruger National Park.

After breakfast, we return to the Blue Train for our homeward journey.

Five course lunch and supper on the Blue Train.

Day 10: Blue Train Arrives in Pretoria

This morning we enjoy breakfast on the Blue Train.

Blue Train arrives in Pretoria.

We disembark the Blue Train and are chauffeur driven to our respective homes.
