After check-in at Steenberg Hotel & Spa we enjoy supper at Tryn Restaurant.


## Day 4: Easy Like Sunday Morning

Our journey begins at a wine farm renowned for its picturesque gardens, organic produce, and status as one of the most Instagram-worthy destinations in the country. Here we have an opportunity to indulge in locally produced meats and cheeses while sampling the estate's top wines.

As the French say, "there is nothing better than aged wine, except perhaps an aged cheese". At our next stop, this adage is taken to heart, offering a cheese pairing that would make even Napoleon weep with joy. The venue, known for its French proprietors and their passion for producing exceptional wine, is the perfect place to savour a variety of exquisite cheeses. For those who are a fan of cheese, traditional biltong pairing is an alternative.





After a morning of wine tasting our next stop is for lunch. Known for their delicatessen of delectable deliciousness, the venue for lunch embodies GT Ferreira's popular belief that good food, wine and art come together a perfect lifestyle. The deli's menu changes seasonally and features the very best in locally grown, ethically-farmed and produced ingredients.

As the day draws to an end, we always reach for the chocolate, so why should a day of wine tasting be any different. Our final stop is a wine and chocolate pairing like no other. The estate's resident winemaker teamed up with a local Chocolatier, Richard von Geusau, to develop a selection of milk and dark chocolates that pair perfectly with the estate's Shiraz, Cabernet, Sauvignon and naturally sweet wines.

Return to the hotel for supper.



## Day 7: Penguins, Peninsula and Pinotage

The city of Cape Town is big and filled with life but its not the whole story. The Southern Peninsula is simply spectacular with views of various mountains lining the shores, the beaches and the oceans as well as fauna and flora. This morning after breakfast we go on a magical mystery tour of the most scenic areas of the Cape.



We start in the hugely popular Hout Bay, a coastal town famous for Chapman's Peak and its stunning bay. It's a great place to grab a cup of coffee and we go just to the right spot.

Lunch is a menu packed with fresh seafood and views of the ocean.


