Day 2: Rooibos Tea Experience

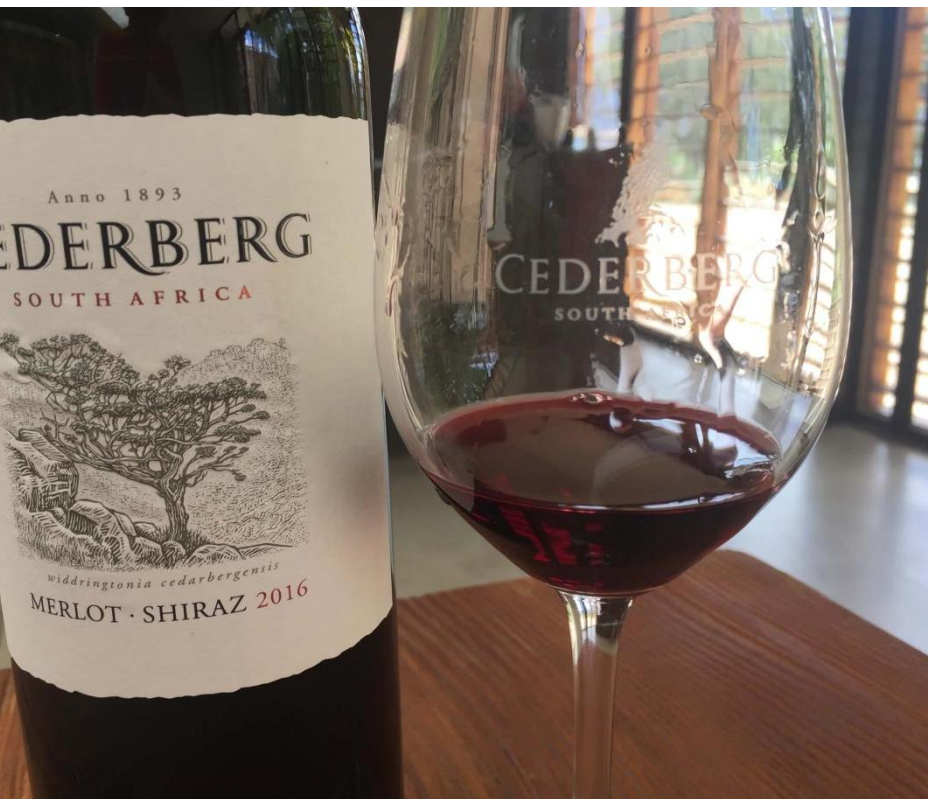


Cederberg is the only place in the world where Rooibos tea can be grown. Today, after breakfast, we head out to Rooibos farm for a fascinating Rooibos Tea Farm excursion to see how it is grown and processed into tea. We will then finish the Rooibos excursion with a tea tasting. After the Rooibos farm excursion, we visit the House of Rooibos. House of Rooibos features a tearoom for some refreshing cup of Rooibos, information centre and a shop where they stock exciting range of original, flavoured and blended Rooibos

teas, Rooibos related food and cosmetic products, souvenirs and gifts items including a recipe book full of Rooibos inspired dishes.

Lunch and afternoon relaxation at Veldskoendraai Restaurant.
We return to the hotel for relaxation and supper.

Day 3: Rock Art Tour and Wine Tasting



After breakfast we go on a full day tour into the High Cederberg Stadsaal and Cederberg Cellars. The San and Khoi people inhabited the Cederberg area from early times, leaving behind rich legacy of rock art. Cederberg Stadsaal Caves has some of the best-preserved Bushman rock art to see. These rock art are a must for all Cederberg visitors and Instagram photo opportunity.

Thereafter, we visit the Cederberg Cellars, the highest wine estate in South Africa and one of the best with several award-winning wines for some wine tasting, lunch and opportunity to purchase what tickles your taste buds.

Supper at the hotel.

Day 4: Clanwilliam Tour

Today after breakfast we visit the bustling country town of Clanwilliam, the seventh oldest town in South Africa.

At Clanwilliam Museum to learn about Cederberg unique history from the San Bushman people and their rock art to the European Settlers and the Anglo-Boer War.

We find out what makes this peaceful part of South Africa tick with displays on citrus farming, Rooibos Tea, and leather goods.

We also walk down Park Street to see the pretty 1820 Settlers Heroes. These are smaller, simpler version of Cape Dutch houses in the winelands.

Mid-morning snack and coffee at Thi Art Café.

We also visit the Strassbergers Shoe Factory to pick up a pair of immensely comfortable “veldskoen”, hand-made working boots for every use.

Lunch and afternoon relaxation at De Kelder Pub & Grill.

We later return to the hotel for supper.



Day 5: Comedy Night



This morning after breakfast we spent the morning at leisure at the hotel to enjoy the hotel facilities which includes sitting room with bar, library with books and Smart TV, large swimming pool and indigenous garden and croquet lawn.

Lunch at Muisbosskerm. This is an open beach restaurant on the West Coast near Lamberts Bay. This restaurant is probably the best example of alfresco West Coast hospitality. There's an array of seafood of offer, ass well as delicious home-made bread, paella and crayfish. Muisbosskerm is known for its seafood buffet and a selection of meat dishes including a traditional South African poitjie such as waterblommetjie bredie.

Later we return to the hotel to freshen up for supper and get ready to laugh our lungs out with Mpho Popps Modikoane.



Day 6: Sunday Chillax



Breakfast and morning at leisure at the hotel.

Day 7: Mixed Bag of Adventure

We learn how to find the True South with the Southern Cross and witness a couple thousand stars and even planets with the naked eye.
