
During the day we immerse ourselves and enjoy the lodge with its many facilities for our comfort and relaxation.

Day 6: Hippo and Croc Experience

This morning, after breakfast we venture into the St Lucia Estuary South Africa's first World Heritage Site, Isimangaliso Wetland Park home to Hippos and Crocodiles.

At Isimangaliso Wetlands Park we board the Hippo & Croc Boat Safari, for a 2-hour boat cruise which gets us up close to the resident Hippos and Nile Crocodiles basking on the shores of the Estuary. The total length of the Estuary is 85 km and one of the largest in Africa. It is estimated that more than 800 Hippo's and 1200 Crocodiles reside in the area. The birdlife in the area is magnificent with an amount of 450 species witnessed during the year.



After an eventful morning we visit The Chane Cheese Farm for lunch. This is one of the restaurants to visit in and around Isimangaliso that gives you a full-on experience with your meal. Here we enjoy their delectable cheese platters, or indulge in their burgers, pizzas, or other lunch menus. We also look out over the pine forests while eating our meal, go on a cheese tour, and visit the farm shop in the same place.



After lunch visit Llala Weavers & Fig Tree Café at Hluhluwe. Llala Weaves is the largest wholesaler of handwoven crafts in South Africa. Baskets are made from indigenous raw materials and wire are their specialty. Here there is also a Zulu Cultural Museum where we see fascinating old Zulu antiques and artefacts, Art Gallery which displays art from different African cultures, among others.

Later we return to the lodge for supper.

Day 7: Mind, Body and Soul Rejuvenation

Today after breakfast we find peace for our minds, bodies and soul. We relax, unwind and unplug, it's all about healing and energy. At Rhino Ridge wellness centre they draw on the healing power of the wilderness. We enjoy the tranquil treatment rooms framed over the African bushveld below. Where else can one spot a rhino, giraffe, elephant or zebra while renewing one's body, a truly physical, mental and emotional experience. We stay in the moment, senses awake as we absorb the magnet healing powers of the wilderness on your journey to renewal. Spa treatments include full body massages. Facial care and hands and feet treatments.
